

ORDER NO. 14-18-12

CARR FIRE CLOSURE

SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from August 8, 2018, until the Carr Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Carr Fire Closure Area. The Carr Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Trinity Lake and Trinity County Road 106 (Sec. 20 T37North, R 7W, MDM), then continues south along the western edge of Trinity County Road 106 to its intersection with Shasta County Road 8G012 (Sec. 30 T 36N, R 6W MDM), then continues east along the southern edge of Shasta County Road 8G012 to its intersection with Interstate Highway 5 (Sec. 34 T 36N, R 5W MDM), then continues south along the western edge of Interstate Highway 5 to its intersection with Shasta Lake (Sec. 13 T 35N, R 5W MDM), then continues south along the western edge of Shasta Lake to its intersection with the Shasta Dam (Sec. 15 T 33N, R 5W MDM), then continues south along the western edge of the Sacramento River to its intersection with the Shasta-Trinity National Forest (Sec. 16 T 33N, R 5W MDM), then continues west along the Shasta Trinity National Forest boundary to its intersection with Sec. 8, T33N, R8W, MDM, then continues west along the southern edge of Sec 8, T33N, R8W MDM to its intersection with the western edge of Sec. 8, T33N, R8W MDM, then continues north along the western edge of Sec. 8, T33N, R8W MDM to its intersection with Lewiston Lake (Sec. 8 T 33N, R 8W MDM), then continues north along the eastern edge of Lewiston Lake to its intersection with the Trinity River (Sec. 15 T 34N, R 8W MDM), then continues north along the eastern edge of the Trinity River its intersection with Trinity Lake (Sec. 15 T 34N, R 8W MDM), then continues north along the eastern edge of Trinity Lake back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Carr Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Carr Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

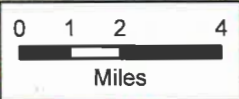
