

**Order No. 05-11-02-18-10**  
**Plumas National Forest**  
**Mt. Hough Ranger District**  
**Minerva 5 Fire Salvage Trail, Road, and Area Closure**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Mt. Hough Ranger District on the Plumas National Forest. This Order is effective from August 11, 2018, through November 30, 2018.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Minerva 5 Fire Salvage Trail, Road, and Area Closure as described in Exhibit A (Closure Description) and shown on Exhibit B (Map). 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Minerva Trail, Road, and Area Closure, including, but not limited to, FS Trail No. 9M35, and FS Trail No. 9M34. 36 CFR 261.55(a).
3. Being on any National Forest System road within the Minerva Trail, Road, and Area Closure, including, but not limited to, FS Road No. 24N20 (Mill Creek Road), FS Road No. 24N20B, FS Road No. 24N20E, FS Road No. 24N20F, FS Road No. 24N20G, FS Road No. 24N20G1, FS Road No. 24N20K, FS Road No. 24N21, FS Road No. 24N21A, FS Road No. 24N21B, FS Road No. 24N21C, FS Road No. 24N21D, FS Road No. 24N26, and FS Road No. 24N26K. 36 CFR 261.54(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work within the Minerva 5 Fire Salvage Sale Area, Roads and Trails Closure Area and their employees, sub-contractors, or agents are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

**Exhibit A**

The boundary of the Minerva 5 Fire Salvage Sale Trail, Roads and Area Closure starts at the intersection of Forest Road No. 24N20 (Mill Creek Road) and the National Forest Boundary in section 19 in Township 24 North, Range 10 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian ("MDB&M") then continues southwest along and including Forest Road No. 24N20 approximately 0.9 miles to its intersection with the National Forest Boundary and the east boundary of Section 24, Township 24 North, Range 9 East, MDB&M, then continues due south approximately 0.3 miles to the southeast corner of Section 24, then continues due west approximately 1 mile to the southwest corner of Section 24, then continues due south approximately 2 miles to the southeast corner of Section 35, then continues due west approximately 2 miles to the southwest corner of Section 34, then continues due north approximately 0.9 miles to the intersection of the west boundary of Section 34 and Forest Road No. 24N26, then continues west approximately 0.5 miles along and including Forest Road No. 24N26 to the intersection of Forest Road No. 24N26 and Forest Road No. 24N87, then continues due north approximately 1 mile to the north boundary of Section 28, then continues due east approximately 1 mile to the intersection of the north boundary of Section 27 and Forest Road No. 24N20, then continues east along and including Forest Road No. 24N20 approximately 3.8 miles to the intersection of the Forest Road No. 24N20 and the National Forest Boundary within Section 24, then continues due north approximately 0.35 miles to the corner of National Forest Boundary, then continues due east approximately 0.5 miles back to the starting point, as shown in Exhibit B.
