**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SPANISH FORK RANGER DISTRICT**

TEMPORARY TRAILHEAD AND TRAILS CLOSURE ORDER

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System trailhead and trails described in this order. The trailhead and trails affected are all within the Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch Cache National Forest. This order is in effect August 11, 2018 through September 30, 2018 or until rescinded.

1. **Being in or upon the Trailhead for Teat Hollow and Knoll Hollow trails including, Teat Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #202) and Knoll Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #076)** as described below and shown on the attached map. This includes all pedestrian, equestrian, bicycle and any type of motorized vehicle. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The trailhead for both the Teat Hollow and Knoll Hollow trails is closed. The Teat Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #202) is closed from the trailhead at the forest boundary on the south then north to Forest Service road #070. The Knoll Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #076) is closed from Sheep Creek road (Forest Service road #051) then west to the intersection with the Teat Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #202). The Trailhead is located in Township 6 South, Range 5 East, Section 34; Teat Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #202) located in Township 6 South, Range 5 East, Sections 34, 27, and 22; Knoll Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #076) is located in Township 6 South, Range 5 East, Sections 34, 27 and 26 all within the Salt Lake Based Meridian, see attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is for public health and safety while fire crews and equipment are suppressing the Coal Hollow fire.

IMPLEMENTATIONS:

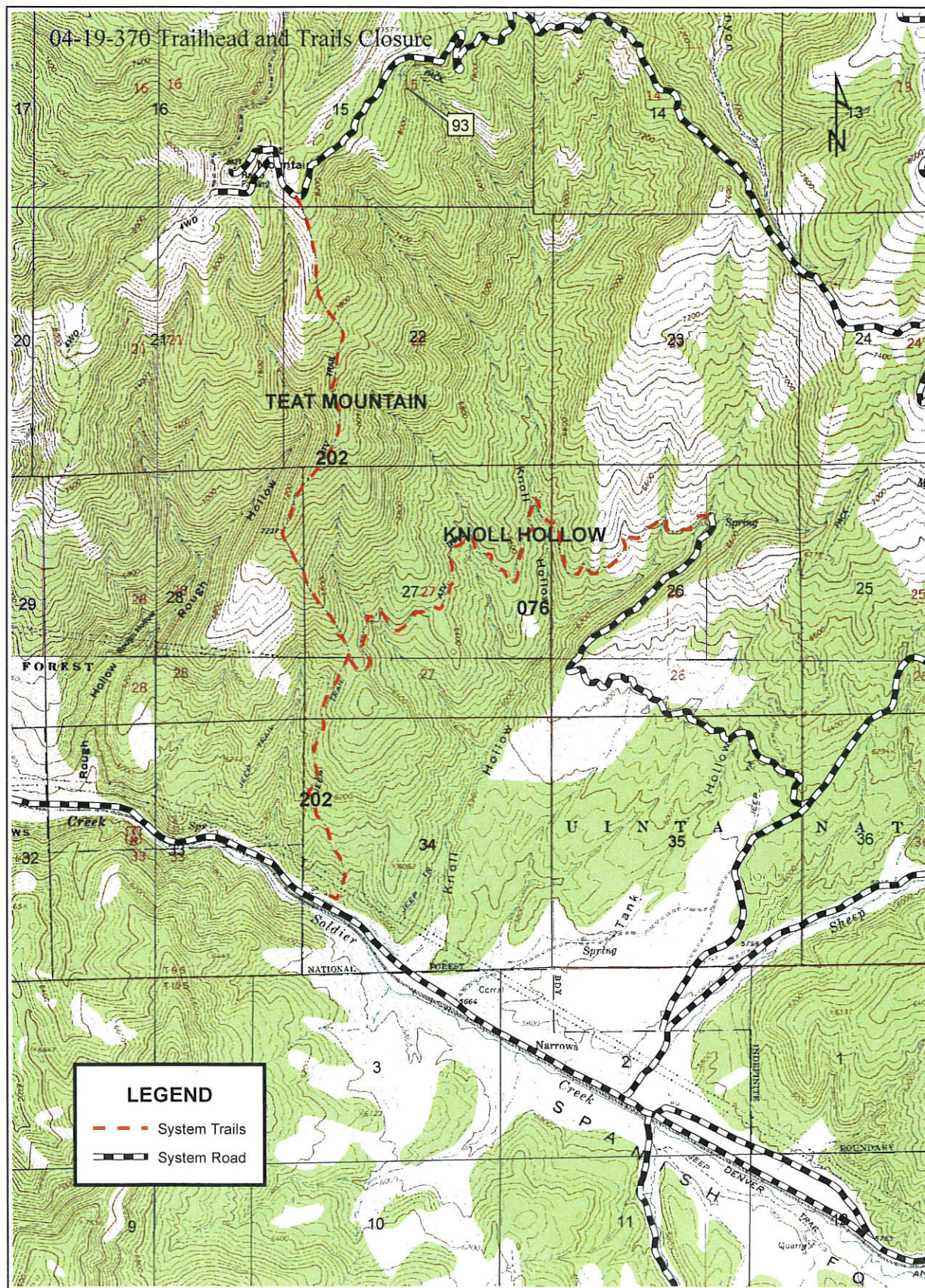
1. This Order will be in effect when signed August 11, 2018 and shall remain in effect through September 30, 2018 or until rescinded.
2. Attached map shows the areas affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].
