ORDER NO. 08-01-07-18-01

Temporary Closure

Pursuant to the provisions of 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited at the Thloko Okhusee Pond. The Area is located in Section 31 of Range 25 East and Township 18 North on the Tuskegee Ranger District of the National Forests in Alabama.

- 1. To close the Thloko and Okhusee Fish Ponds (also referred to as Patillo Ponds) within the Tuskegee National Forest located off Forest Service Road 911. The closure will help maintain the current fish stocking levels, allow time for growth and reproduction, and improvement of current fish habitat. This order is effective immediately until Saturday June 1, 2019.**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Montgomery Alabama this 13 day of August 2018.
