



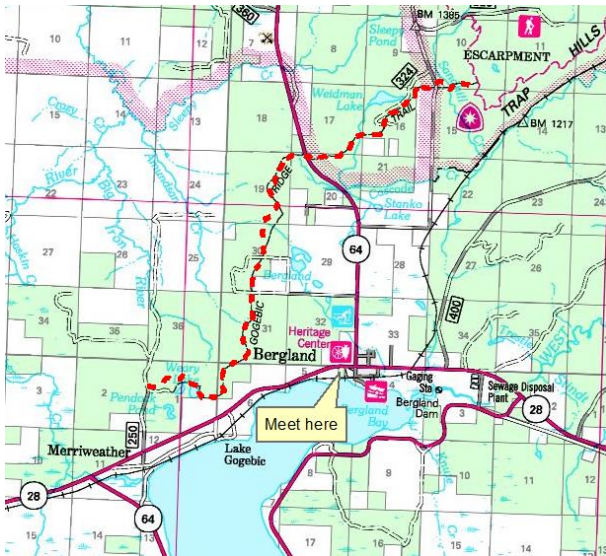

### Help work on the Gogebic Ridge Trail!

The Ottawa National Forest is hosting a National Public Lands Day event at the Gogebic Ridge Trail in Ontonagon County, Michigan. Volunteers will help clear specific sections of the 9-mile hiking trail, which runs from Forest Road 250 (west of Bergland) to the North Country National Scenic Trail (in the Trap Hills). The trail includes several scenic rock bluff overlooks.



**When:** Saturday, September 22, 2018. 10:00 AM EDT, 9:00 AM CDT.

**Where:** Meet at the Bergland Cultural & Heritage Center, located on the south side of Highway M28 in Bergland, 1/4 mile west of the intersection with Highway M64. There we will discuss the planned work, divide into groups, and arrange drop-off and pick-up locations along the trail.

**What to bring:** Water, boots, and a picnic lunch. We will supply drinks, gloves, tools, and safety equipment.
