**ORDER NO. 2004-02-15
SPECIAL CLOSURE**

PURSUANT TO 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE PROHIBITION HEREINAFTER SET FORTH APPLIES TO THE **CAMP SHELBY PERMIT AREA "A"** (BOMBING/IMPACT AREA), LOCATED WITHIN THE DE SOTO RANGER DISTRICT, WHICH IS PART OF THE DE SOTO NATIONAL FOREST, AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

THIS CLOSURE ORDER WILL BE EFFECTIVE FROM AUGUST 1, 2014 UNTIL EXPIRATION OF THE MISSISSIPPI MILITARY DEPARTMENT SPECIAL USE PERMIT #DES0094 ON DECEMBER 31, 2029 UNLESS RESCINDED.

THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED ACTS ARE SET FORTH IN 36 C.F.R. 261.53.

261.53(e) Going into or being upon the Camp Shelby Bombing/Impact Area, which is closed for the protection of public health and safety.

Area closure descriptions are as follows: National Forest Road 310 (Grapevine Road) to National Forest Road 35000 (South Tank Trail) to National Forest Road 305 (Red Hill Road) to National Forest Road 304 (Davis Range Road) to National Forest Road 369-B (Harrison Tank Trail) and back to National Forest Road 310 (Grapevine Road), as described on the attached map.


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any federal, state, local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.
- (3) Any authorized person(s) engaged in official administrative duties regarding Camp Shelby Bombing/Impact Area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. part 261, Subpart A.




OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551, and Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act of omissions are prohibited on Bethel OHV Trail and Rattlesnake Bay OHV Trail, located on the lands within the **De Soto National Forest, De Soto Ranger District administered by the National Forests in Mississippi.**


This closure order is effective from July 1, 2017 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

1. **Camping for a period longer than seven (7) consecutive nights at the trailhead** 36 CFR 261.58(a)
2. **Using a vehicle over 50 inches wide.** 36 CFR 261.55(d)
3. **Parking or leaving in violation of posted instruction.** 36 CFR 261.58(j)
4. **Shortcutting a switchback.** 36 CFR 261.55(e)
5. **Being on a trail after sundown and before sunrise.** 36 CFR 261.55(a)
6. **Operating, using any internal combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order.** 36 CFR 261.55(d)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer engaged in the performance of an official duty.
2. Any authorized person engaged in official administrative duties regarding National Forest Administration.





Location Map**






De Soto National Forest De Soto Ranger District Rattlesnake Bay OHV Trail Location Map

OCCUPANCY AND USE

BIG BILOXI RECREATION AREA

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551, and Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act of omissions are prohibited in the Big Biloxi Recreation Area located on the lands within the **De Soto National Forest, De Soto Ranger District administered by the National Forests in Mississippi.**

This closure order is effective from July 1, 2017 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

1. **Entering the area between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM, except a person who is camping or is visiting a person camping in that area. 36 CFR 261.58(u)**
2. **Camping for a period longer than fourteen (14) consecutive nights, from May through October, and thirty (30) consecutive nights from November through April. 36 CFR 261.58(a)**
3. **No more than two (2) vehicles per campsite. 36 CFR 261.58(i)**
4. **Possessing, parking, or leaving more than two (2) vehicles, except motorcycles, or bicycles per camp site. 36 CFR 261.58(g)**
5. **Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun. 36 CFR 261.58(m)**
6. **No more than four (4) people or one family per campsite. 36 CFR 261.58(f)**
7. **Operating a motor vehicle in excess of posted 10 MPH speed limit. 36 CFR 261.54(d)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer engaged in the performance of an official duty.
2. Any authorized person engaged in official administrative duties regarding National Forest Administration.




POSSESSION OF GLASS CONTAINERS

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551, and Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act of omissions are prohibited on the lands within the **De Soto National Forest, De Soto Ranger District administered by the National Forests in Mississippi.**

This closure order is effective from July 1, 2017 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

POSSESSION OF ANY GLASS CONTAINER WITHIN 100 FEET OF THE FOLLOWING STREAMS AND LAKES.

BLACK CREEK, POTATO CREEK, BEAVER DAM CREEK, RED CREEK, BILOXI RIVER, TUXACHANIE CREEK, TCHOUTACABOUFFA RIVER, HURRICANE CREEK, ASHE LAKE, AIREY LAKE, AND P.O.W. LAKE – 36 C.F.R. 261.53(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer engaged in the performance of an official duty.
2. Any authorized person engaged in official administrative duties regarding National Forest Administration.

OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551, and Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act of omissions are prohibited lands within the **De Soto National Forest, De Soto Ranger District administered by the National Forests in Mississippi.**

Area descriptions are as follows:

Airey Lake Recreation Area, Ashe Lake Recreation Area, Big Creek Recreation Area, Big Foot Trail Head, Cypress Creek Recreation Area, Fairley Bridge Recreation Area, Janice Landing Recreation Area, Moody's Landing Recreation Area, P.O.W. Recreation Area, Big Biloxi Recreation Area, and Bethel ATV Trail Head.

This closure order is effective from July 1, 2017 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

1. **Being in the area between 10 PM and 6 AM, except a person who is camping or visiting a person camping, or persons fishing.** 36 CFR 261.58(u)
2. **Camping for a period longer than fourteen (14) consecutive nights, except for P.O.W. Lake Recreation, Airey Lake, Big Foot Trail Head, and Bethel ATV Trail Head, which is seven (7) consecutive nights.** 36 CFR 261.58(a)
3. **Swimming at Airey Lake, P.O.W. Lake, or Ashe Lake.** 36 CFR 261.58(k)
4. **Operation of a gasoline powered boat motor or personal watercraft in Airey Lake, P.O.W. Lake, or Ashe Lake.** 36 CFR 261.58(w)
5. **Hunting.** 36 CFR 261.58(v)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer engaged in the performance of an official duty.
2. Any authorized person engaged in official administrative duties regarding National Forest Administration.





Airey Lake Recreation Area; Ashe Lake Recreation Area; Big Biloxi Recreation Area; Big Creek Landing Recreation Area; Big Foot Trail Head; Black Creek Shooting Range; C.C. Parking Lot; Cypress Creek Recreation Area; Fairley Bridge Recreation Area; Black Creek Trail Highway 29 Parking Lot; Janice Landing Recreation Area and Boat Ramp; Leaf Trail Parking Lot; Moody's Landing Recreation Area; P.O.W. Lake Recreation Area; Rattlesnake Bay ATV Trail Parking Lot; Bethel ATV Trail Head, South Bethel Motorcycle Trail Head; and South Bethel Bike Trail Head - 36 C.F.R. 261.58(bb).
