

**CONDITIONS REPORT****CAMPGROUNDS****STATUS**

<b>WARNER LAKE</b>	Open. First come/first serve. Need high clearance 4 wheel drive to access- about 10-12" of snow at campground. 4 wheel drive needed to access. No water available.
<b>OOWAH</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available.- a few inches of snow in campground. May need 4 wheel drive to access.
<b>MASON DRAW</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. Snow likely in campground.
<b>BUCKEYE</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. There may be snow.
<b>DEVILS CANYON</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. North loop is closed so only 16 sites available. There may be snow.
<b>NIZHONI</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. May need 4 wheel drive to access. There may be snow.
<b>BUCKBOARD</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. There may be snow.
<b>DALTON SPRINGS</b>	Open. First come/First serve. No Water available. There may be snow in campground.
<b>TRAILS</b>	
<b>BURRO PASS</b>	Closed by 2 1/2 feet or more of snow
<b>HAZARD</b>	Closed by about a foot of snow at the top.
<b>UPS/KOKOPELLI</b>	Open- Muddy. Please don't ride if it will damage the trail.
<b>JIMMY KEEN</b>	Open- Muddy. Please don't ride if it will damage the trail.
<b>MOONLIGHT MEADOWS</b>	Closed by snow. Likely two feet of snow on trail.
<b>LA SAL PASS: SOUTH MTN. &amp; BURLFRIENDS</b>	Likely closed by over a foot of snow at top.
<b>ROADS</b>	
<b>LA SAL LOOP ROAD</b>	Open. Clear. This road is plowed if it snows.
<b>GEYSER PASS</b>	Likely impassable by over two feet of snow at the top. High clearance/ 4 wheel drive necessary. Plows to the winter recreation trailhead have not started yet.
<b>LA SAL PASS</b>	Open but likely impassable by snow. 4 wheel drive is necessary from the Pack Creek side. Snow at the top is more than two feet deep.
<b>GATEWAY</b>	Open - May have snow. Have not had any reports on it yet.
<b>SAND FLATS</b>	Open- May be muddy.
<b>TWO MILE AREA</b>	Open- May be muddy. Snow at higher elevations. May need high clearance 4 wheel drive.
<b>HARTS DRAW</b>	Open- There may be snow towards the top.
<b>NORTH CREEK</b>	Open- Likely impassable at the higher elevations. Muddy at lower elevations.
<b>CAUSEWAY</b>	Open- Muddy conditions- May need high clearance 4 wheel drive
<b>SOUTH ELKS</b>	Open- Muddy conditions- May need high clearance 4 wheel drive
<b>BEARS EARS</b>	Open- Muddy conditions- May need high clearance 4 wheel drive
<b>South &amp; North COTTONWOOD</b>	Open- Muddy conditions- May need high clearance 4 wheel drive
<b>NORTH LONG POINT</b>	4 wheel drive is probably necessary. There is snow at higher elevations.
<b>ABAJO PEAK/ SOUTH PEAK</b>	Open but likely impassable due to snow
<b>ELK RIDGE</b>	Open- Muddy conditions- May need high clearance 4 wheel drive
<b>DARK CANYON ACCESS</b>	<b>Watch the weather. Roads can be impassable when wet.</b>
<b>WOODENSHOE TRAILHEAD</b>	Muddy. High clearance recommended. You may need 4 wheel drive. Water is available in Woodenshoe canyon
<b>PEAVINE TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- Muddy. High clearance recommended. You may need 4 wheel drive. Water in Dark Canyon upstream from Peavine canyon intersection.
<b>HORSE PASTURE TRAILHEAD</b>	Muddy. High clearance recommended. You may need 4 wheel drive.
<b>THE NOTCH TRAILHEAD</b>	Muddy. High clearance recommended. You may need 4 wheel drive.
<b>DRY MESA ROAD</b>	Muddy. High clearance recommended. You may need 4 wheel drive.
<b>PEAVINE CORRIDOR ROAD</b>	Open- 4 wheel drive needed- narrow, very rough road
<b>SUNDANCE TRAILHEAD</b>	Open. <b>BLM trailhead</b> accessible from West. Water likely from perennial stream.
<b>TRAIL CANYON TRAILHEAD</b>	Open. High clearance, 4 wheel drive needed to access trailhead. No Water in canyon.
