

ORDER NO. 14-18-20
SLATE CREEK CLOSURE
SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2019.

1. Going into or being upon any National Forest System lands within the Slate Creek Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Slate Creek Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Slate Creek Closure Area as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Owners or lessees of land in the Slate Creek Closure Area, to the extent necessary to access their land.
2. Residents in the Slate Creek Closure Area, to the extent necessary to access their residences.
3. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
4. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



The Hirz Delta Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of the boundary of the west edge of California Interstate Highway 5 and Shasta County Road 8G012 (Dog Creek Rd) (Section 34, Township 36N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues west along the north edge of Shasta County Road 8G012 (Dog Creek Rd.) to its intersection with the east edge of Section 35, Township 36N, Range 6W, MDM, then continues due north along the Section line to its intersection with the south edge of Section 26, Township 36N, Range 6W, MDM, then continues due west along the Section line to its intersection with the east edge of Forest Road No. 36N63 (Crestline / Damn Slate Rd.) (Section 27, Township 36N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues north along the east edge of Forest Road No. 36N63 (Crestline / Damn Slate Rd.) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 37N08Y (Hall Gulch Rd. FA08) (Section 3, Township 36N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues north along the east edge of Forest Road No. 37N08Y (Hall Gulch Rd. FA08) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 37N15 (Shoemaker Rd.) (Section 27, Township 37N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues north along the east edge of Forest Road No. 37N15 (Shoemaker Rd.) to its intersection with the south edge of Section 11, Township 37N, Range 6W, MDM, then continues due east along the section line to its intersection with the west side of Forest Road No. 38N21 (Highland Lakes Rd.) (Section 18, Township 37N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues south along the west edge of Forest Road No. 38N21 (Highland Lakes Rd.) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 37N26 (Cone Rd.) (Section 28, Township 37N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues west along the north edge of Forest Road No. 37N26 (Cone Rd.) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 37N31 (Boulder Creek Rd.) (Section 28, Township 37N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues south along the west edge of Forest Road No. 37N31 (Boulder Creek Rd.) to its intersection with the boundary of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest (Section 32, Township 37N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues south and east along the boundary of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest to its intersection with the west edge of Section 2, Township 36N, Range 5W, MDM, then continues due east along the Section line to its intersection with the west edge of California Interstate Highway 5 (Section 2, Township 36N, Range 5W, MDM), then continues south along the west edge of California Interstate Highway 5 back to its starting point as shown on the attached map.
