FOREST ORDER

Fire

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the Apalachicola National Forest:

Going into or being upon an area burned over by human caused fires for the purpose of harvesting or collecting bait (worms) (36 CFR 261.52(e))


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above Prohibitions:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.

This Order is effective this 3rd day of February 2014, and will remain in effect until terminated by appropriate authorized personnel.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of the above prohibition set forth, are punishable by fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than (6) six months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
