WARNER LAKE	CLOSED. ROAD TO WARNER LAKE IS CLOSED. Gate is locked.
OOWAH	CLOSED. ROAD TO OOWAH LAKE IS CLOSED. Gate is locked.
MASON DRAW	Open. No water available.
BUCKEYE	Open- No water available. The road from the Two Mile area may be muddy and require high clearance and/or 4WD. There have been some washouts by rain and melt off.
DEVILS CANYON	OPEN- No potable water available
NIZHONI	OPEN- No potable water available
BUCKBOARD	OPEN- No potable water available
DALTON SPRINGS	OPEN- No potable water available
TRAILS	
BURRO PASS	CLOSED BY SNOW
HAZARD	CLOSED BY SNOW
UPS/KOKOPELLI	Open
JIMMY KEEN	Muddy. Please do not ride. Riding muddy trails damages them.
MOONLIGHT MEADOWS	CLOSED BY SNOW
LA SAL PASS: SOUTH MTN. & BURLFRIENDS	CLOSED BY SNOW
ROADS	Spring = Mud, washouts, & high creek crossings. There is snow still at the higher elevations.
LA SAL LOOP ROAD	Open.
GEYSER PASS	CLOSED because of snow. 4WD is necessary to the winter recreation area due to mud and snow drifts. East side of Geyser Pass is open to SITLA winter use area, but snow drifts make it impassable after the parking area.
LA SAL PASS	CLOSED around the aspen treeline by snow. La Sal creek is running high. Would need higher clearance to cross.
GATEWAY	Open but possibly impassable due to mud.
SAND FLATS	Open. May be rutted.
TWO MILE AREA	Open. Mud and some washouts may require AWD/4WD and/or high clearance.
HARTS DRAW	Open.
NORTH CREEK	CLOSED. Gate is locked on both sides.
CAUSEWAY	Open. Still muddy in patches and rutted in places. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy.
SOUTH ELKS	Open. Still muddy in patches and rutted in places. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy.
BEARS EARS	Open. Still muddy in patches and rutted in places. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy.
South & North COTTONWOOD	Open. High clearance recommended. Cottonwood creek is running high. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy.
NORTH LONG POINT	Open but muddy in patches and rutted in places. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy. 4WD recommended.
ABAJO PEAK/ SOUTH PEAK	CLOSED by snow.
ELK RIDGE	Open. Snow in patches at higher elevations. Muddy and rutted in places. Side roads and shoulders may be soft and very muddy. 4WD recommended.
DARK CANYON ACCESS	Watch the weather. Roads can be impassable when wet.
WOODENSHOE TRAILHEAD	Open- trail damaged due to washouts and excess water.
PEAVINE TRAILHEAD	Open- trail damaged due to washouts and excess water.
HORSE PASTURE TRAILHEAD	Open- trailhead is very muddy. 4WD recommended.
THE NOTCH TRAILHEAD	Open- trailhead is very muddy. 4WD recommended.
DRY MESA ROAD	Not passable. A landslide has taken out the road.
PEAVINE CORRIDOR ROAD	Washed out. Not advisable for travel right now. Water flowing on the road and deep ruts
TRAIL CANYON TRAILHEAD	Open- trailhead is very muddy. 4WD recommended.
SUNDANCE TRAILHEAD	Open. BLM trailhead accessible from West. Water flowing from perennial stream. No fires are allowed on the BLM portion of Dark Canyon. Road to reach the trailhead could be impassable when wet. Monticello BLM 435-587-1500
