<b>NIZHONI</b>	Open- potable water
<b>OOWAH LAKE</b>	Open- No water available. Lake will be drained 9/8 and the road closed to ALL traffic 9/14/2020
<b>WARNER LAKE</b>	Open except for cabin which will remain closed- no water available

<b>CAUSEWAY</b>	Open
<b>GATEWAY</b>	Open. May need a higher clearance vehicle with 4WD/AWD to cross to Gateway.
<b>GEYSER PASS</b>	Open
<b>HARTS DRAW</b>	Open
<b>LA SAL LOOP ROAD</b>	Open
<b>LA SAL PASS</b>	Open- Narrow, rough, 4WD road from the Pack Creek area. May not be suitable for full sized vehicles.
<b>NORTH CREEK</b>	Open
<b>OOWAH LAKE Road</b>	<b>The road to Oowah Lake will be CLOSED at the La Sal Mtn Loop Rd from Sept. 14- October 10, 2020. The road will be closed to ALL USERS as repairs are being completed. The trails and campground will remain open but must be accessed by the trail system.</b>
<b>SAND FLATS</b>	Open
<b>South &amp; North COTTONWOOD</b>	Open but may be washed out completely due to storm. South Cottonwood Road was impassable 8/28/20.
<b>SOUTH ELKS</b>	Open
<b>TWO MILE AREA</b>	Open.

<b>BEARS EARS</b>	Open
<b>DRY MESA ROAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle.
<b>ELK RIDGE</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle.
<b>HORSE PASTURE TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle
<b>NORTH LONG POINT</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle.
<b>PEAVINE CORRIDOR ROAD</b>	Open. Not recommended for full sized vehicles. Narrow, off camber, steep 4WD road.
<b>PEAVINE TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle
<b>THE NOTCH TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle
<b>TRAIL CANYON TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle
<b>WOODENSHEOE TRAILHEAD</b>	Open- May need a higher clearance AWD/4WD vehicle
<b>SUNDANCE TRAILHEAD</b>	BLM trailhead accessible from the west. No fires are allowed on the BLM portion of Dark Canyon. Monticello BLM: 435-587-1500
