Mark Twain National Forest – Potosi/Fredericktown Ranger District

Palmer Lead Smelter Area Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Potosi/Fredericktown Ranger District. This Order is effective from March 29, 2019 until rescinded.

Entering or being in the Palmer Lead Smelter Closure Area. The boundary of the Palmer Lead Smelter Closure Area is defined by the marked and signed area surrounding the Palmer smelter site located north of Forest Service road 2392 at Hazel Creek Campground and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into the Order as Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of official duty.
2. Any site worker duly authorized by the Forest Service to perform work within the closure area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


T36N, R1W, 5thPM; Section 14 & 15
