The Tall Pines Discovery Trail is an interpretive trail with two loops. Each loop is about a mile in length. Interpretation focuses on environmental science topics in longleaf pine ecosystems. The trail winds through longleaf pine stands and provides views of several ponds and a wildlife opening. The trail is an easy hike and there is no fee.

Wearing hunter orange colored clothing during deer hunting season is recommended

#### Directions:

From Laurel, take state HWY 15 south for 15 miles to Forest Service Road 202. Turn left (east) on Forest Service Road 202 and travel 2 miles. The trailhead is on the south side of Forest Service Road 202.
