SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT

TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System area described in this order. The area affected is located on the Salt Lake Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting June 15th, 2019 until rescinded.

1. **Being in or upon** the area as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian, hikers, bikers,

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The area closed is south of Little Cottonwood trail, on the north side of Little Cottonwood Canyon in the area of the now removed Whitmore Pavilion, specifically the area revegetated and the restored rockslide which is immediately south of the revegetation area. The closure would range from the edge of the access road used by Whitmore Oxygen (the turnaround is in part the trail) crossing the area of the removed pavilion structure and up the hill to the top of the rockslide (full width and length of the rockslide), located in located in Township 2 South, Range 1 East, Section 25 and Township 2 South, Range 2 East, Section 30, all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian. As shown on the attached map.


PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to allow the area time to revegetate

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed June 15, 2019 and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
