FOREST ORDER USDA FOREST SERVICE ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST Clear Creek Ranger District

National Forest Occupancy and Use Restrictions

Pursuant to Title 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Clear Creek Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest that are located in Clear Creek County depicted in Exhibit A and herein referred to as the "Warren Gulch Trail #47".

The purpose of this Order is to ensure visitor safety and to assure the protection of resources. The trail as described in this order are depicted on the attached map Exhibit A, and covers 50 feet either from centerline of the trail.

PROHIBITIONS:

The following is prohibited:

1. Being on the Trail. 36 CFR 261.55(a).)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR 261.50(e)(1));
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)); or
- 3. Any person possessing a valid Colorado hunting license lawfully involved in hunting and harvesting game (36 CFR 261.50(e)(6)).

Done at Fort Collins, Colorado. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or December 31, 2021, whichever occurs first.
