

**ORDER**

**OCCUPANCY AND USE**

USDA – FOREST SERVICE  
COLUMBIA RIVER GORGE NATIONAL SCENIC AREA

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers portion of the White Salmon River, within the Counties of Klickitat and Skamania, State of Washington, Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area.

1. Entering or being on the waters with a boat, watercraft, vehicle or other device that is self-propelled by an internal combustion engine or self-propelled by electrical power.

36 CFR 261.58(z)

Description of the portion of the White Salmon River to which this prohibition applies


Beginning at approximately River Mile 5.2 at the intersection of the natural gas pipe line and the White Salmon River north of Northwestern Lake in the SW ¼ of SE ¼ of Section 35, Township 4 N, Range 10 E, Willamette Meridian, and proceeding upstream in a northerly direction to approximately River Mile 12.5 at the confluence of Gilmer Creek and the White Salmon River north of BZ Corner in the SE ¼ of SW ¼ of Section 2, Township 4 N, Range 10 E, Willamette Meridian.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
