OCCUPANCY AND USE

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the area described in this Order (the "Restricted Area") and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Coronado National Forest, and Cochise, Pima, Santa Cruz, Pinal, and Graham Counties, within the state of Arizona and within Hidalgo County within the state of New Mexico.

1. Camping for more than 14 days within any 60-day period. **36 C.F.R. § 261.58(a).**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

RESTRICTED AREA

National Forest System lands within the boundaries of the Coronado National Forest, as depicted in Exhibit A of this Order.


PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is for the protection of National Forest visitors and employees, the prevention of user conflicts, the conservation of natural resources, and the protection of property belonging to the United States.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until August 1, 2021 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581 (b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
