POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within all National Forest System lands as described in this Order (the “Restricted Area”) and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Coronado National Forest within the states of Arizona and New Mexico.

1. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by state law.
36 C.F.R. § 261.58(bb)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Persons 21 years of age or older and not otherwise under any legal restriction regarding the possession of an alcoholic beverage under applicable state law.

RESTRICTED AREA

The Restricted Area encompasses all National Forest System lands within the boundaries of the Coronado National Forest, as depicted in Exhibit A.

PURPOSE


The purpose of this Order is to comply with Arizona and New Mexico state law and to restrict underage consumption of alcoholic beverages in order to provide for public health and safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be effective when signed and shall remain in effect until August 1, 2021 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.

3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
