

Reconstruction Update: National Forest System road 427



Boise National Forest is reconstructing NFS road 427 (Stolle Meadows Road) beginning August 5, 2019

A road closure will be in place **Monday through Friday** from 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1- 5 p.m. daily. **Please note: Road closures will not be in place through the weekends but, dispersed camping will be closed for the duration of the project.**

Specific work scheduled August 5 –19:

- Installing detour and road closed signs.
- Felling and decking trees within clearing limits.
- Removing vegetation within the project clearing limits.

WHAT WORK IS BEING DONE?

The purpose of the project is to widen the roadway, construct road shoulders, install additional drainage culverts, relocate utilities, and provide aggregate and asphalt surfacing. Construction is expected through the 2019 field season (Nov. 2019).
