



**CLOSURE ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
RESTRICTING OCCUPANCY AND USE, TO WIT:
MONONGAHELA NATIONAL FOREST,
GAULEY RANGER DISTRICT, WEST VIRGINIA**


Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in order to provide for public health and safety on and along Forest Road (FR) 86 on the Monongahela National Forest, Pocahontas and Webster Counties, West Virginia.

1. **Prohibitions:** The following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land on and along FR 86, the Williams River Road, between Gate 2, downstream of Tea Creek Campground, to Gate 3, near Three Forks Bridge, as shown on the map attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, dated 08/02/2019.
 - a. Operating a motor vehicle. 36 CFR § 261.54 (a)
 - b. Being on the road (walking, bicycling, riding a horse, etc.) where road construction activities are occurring and when that specific segment of road is closed by a sign, gate, or barricade. 36 CFR § 261.54 (e)
 - c. Going into or being upon an area from the center of Williams River to 100 feet south of FR 86 where road construction activities are occurring and when that specific segment of road is closed by a sign, gate, or barricade. 36 CFR § 261.53 (e)
2. **Duration:** The prohibitions of this Order shall remain in effect from the date of signature until terminated by the Forest Supervisor.
3. **Exemptions:** Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the prohibitions contained in this Order:
 - a. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR § 261.50 (e) (1));
 - b. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR § 261.50 (e) (4)).
4. **General Prohibitions:** The General Prohibitions set forth in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A (§§ 261.1-261.23), remain in effect. The prohibitions set forth herein pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (§§ 261.50-261.58) are in addition to the General Prohibitions.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
