FOREST ORDER

USDA FOREST SERVICE ARAPAHO AND ROOSEVELT NATIONAL FORESTS AND PAWNEE NATIONAL GRASSLAND **BOULDER RANGER DISTRICT**

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS (NFSR) CLOSURES

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) §§ 261.50 (a) and (b), 261.54 (a) the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Roads NFSR 114.1 Camp Dick and Peaceful Valley campground roads as well as NFSR 114.1 west of Camp Dick campground (Middle St. Vrain), 507.1, 507.1A, 507.1B, 507.1C, and 507.1D (Coney Flats), and NFSR 105 (Bunce School) from the NFSR 114.1 heading north for approximately 0.9 miles to the intersection with NFSR 202.1 (Park Creek), on the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Boulder County, Colorado (hereinafter known as the Restricted Roads). The Restricted Roads are depicted and shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A and a Motor Vehicle as defined in Exhibit B.

The purpose of this Order is to help protect public health and safety due to road bridge replacement activity.

PROHIBITIONS:

• Operating a Motor Vehicle on a Restricted Road. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 3) Over snow vehicles.

This Order shall be in effect when posted and will remain in effect until rescinded, or until December 31, 2019, whichever occurs first.
