Closure Order: 06-21-12-19-04

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Three Rivers Ranger District of the Colville National Forest. This Order is effective September 3, 2019 until September 30, 2019, unless rescinded earlier.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. **Being on any National Forest System Road** as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].

CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:

Travel is prohibited on the following National Forest System (NFS) Roads. See attached map, Exhibit A.

Roads Closed

- NFS Road 6110000 – South Boulder Creek

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owners or lessees of land in the area.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
