**Temporary Area Closure**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the area described in this Order (the “Restricted Area”) and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Camino Real Ranger District, Carson National Forest, Taos County, NM.

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. **36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

**RESTRICTED AREA**

The Restricted Area is within Township 23 North, Range 12 and 13 East, Sections 30, 31, 32, 34, 35, and 36, and Township 22 North, Range 12 and 13 East, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, and 11, specifically all National Forest System lands within the boundary starting at the junction of State Highway 518 and Forest System Road (FR) 422, then following FR 422 east, until its junction with Forest Trail 182, then following Forest Trail 182 south and west until its junction with Forest Trail 7, then following Forest Trail 7 south until its junction with State Highway 518, then following State Highway 518 in a general northerly direction back to the point of beginning at the junction with FR 422, as depicted in Exhibit A of this Order.

**NOTE**

The National Forest System roads and trails described as part of the boundary and interior to the boundary are closed.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to provide for firefighter and public safety, due to wildfire operations within the Restricted Area. These operations include but are not limited to: hazard tree falling, aerial firing ignition operations, hand ignitions, heavy equipment use and fire rehabilitation efforts.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will be effective on September 9, 2019 at 4:00 p.m., and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2019, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.



