

ORDER NO. 08-19-05
MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST FOR
DEVELOPED RECREATION SITE PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in Developed Recreation Sites on the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from September 20, 2019 through September 20, 2021.

1. Camping in the same campground for a period longer than 14 days in any 30-day period. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
2. Camping in the same campground for more than 28 cumulative days in any 12-month period. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
3. Entering or remaining in a campground between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., except for persons who are camping in the campground. 36 CFR 261.58(c).
4. Use of a campsite by more than 8 persons. 36 CFR 261.58(f).
5. Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit. 36 CFR 261.58(h).
6. Being publically nude. 36 CFR 261.58(j).
7. Possessing, parking, or leaving more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles, per camp unit. 36 CFR 261.58(i).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
