

ORDER NO. 08-19-06  
MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST  
DISPERSED CAMPING PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from September 20, 2019 through September 20, 2021.

1. Camping within a one-mile radius of the same location outside of a Developed Recreation Site for a period longer than 14 days in any 30-day period. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
2. Camping within a one-mile radius of the same location outside of a Developed Recreation Site for more than 28 cumulative days in any 12-month period. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
3. Camping within 1 mile of a Developed Recreation Site. 36 CFR 261.58(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
