***TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE***

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the area described in this Order (the "Restricted Area") and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Santa Catalina Ranger District, Coronado National Forest, Pima County, Arizona.

1. Entering or being in a body of water. **36 C.F.R. § 261.58(k)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**RESTRICTED AREA**

The Restricted Area is within Township 12 South, Range 16 East, Section 16, specifically Rose Canyon Lake, located within Rose Canyon on the west side of Forest Road 833 as depicted in Exhibit A of this Order.


**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to allow for the protection of public health, safety, and property, and to provide for a continued quality environment. Rose Canyon Lake is an extremely popular summer recreation spot. Limitations on swimming and boating must be enforced to provide for the lake's main purpose as a fishery.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will be effective on October 1, 2019 at midnight, and shall remain in effect until September 30, 2021, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.




