

THIS ORDER PROHIBITS:

(1) Using any type of vehicle prohibited in this order. This order prohibits use by motorized vehicles on Forest Development Trail number 1384, also known as the Squirrel Creek Trail, and number 1385, also known as the Mountain Park Trail.

36 CFR 261.54 (a)

Forest Development Trail number 1384 (Squirrel Creek Trail) - starting at a point located approximately one-quarter (1/4) mile east of the National Forest Boundary in Section 9, T.23S., R.68W., to the Squirrel Creek Pavilion located approximately one-half (1/2) mile west of the National Forest Boundary in Section 8, T.23S., R.68W., all in the 6th P.M.

Forest Development Trail number 1385 (Mountain Park Trail) - starting at the intersection with trail number 1384 in the NENENE, Section 17, T.23S., R.68W., to the intersection with the North Ridge Trail (No Number) in the NWSWNW, Section 16, T.23S., R.68W., all in the 6th P.M.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) (1) (4), the following persons are exempt from this order:

(1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(4) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
