

FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

-PIKE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on Forest Development Roads within the exterior boundaries of the South Platte Ranger District of the Pike National Forest. Affected Forest Development Roads are listed on the attachment and shown on the map(s) which are made a part of this order that is issued for public safety and to conform with the laws of the State of Colorado.

THIS ORDER PROHIBITS:

The use of all motor vehicles that do not display a current and valid state license plate authorizing their use on public roads.

36 CFR 261.54 (b)

ATTACHMENT TO THIS ORDER:


Affected Forest Development Roads and roads having seasonal exceptions within the South Platte Ranger District as described and shown on the list and map.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a USDA, Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


