VAIL PASS WINTER RECREATION AREA

Difficulty: EASY TO MORE DIFFICULT

Trail Use: Moderate to Heavy

Length: Varies depending on trail

Elevation: 9,200' at Camp Hale to 12,692' at the top of Elk Mountain.

Elevation Gain: Varies depending on trail

Open To: HIKING, X-C SKIING, SNOWSHOEING, SNOWMOBILING

Access:

- East Side: From I-70 take Exit 190, Vail Pass Rest Area, and park in the designated recreation parking area on the west side of I-70.
- West Side: Along Highway 24 there is an entrance at the town of Redcliff and three entrances at several points in the Camp Hale area.
