Notice of Approval of the Revised Land Management Plan

The final record of decision (ROD) for the revised Colville National Forest land management plan (land management plan) was approved by Regional Forester Glenn Casamassa on October 21, 2019, and the land management plan will be effective 30 days after publication of the notice of land management plan approval in the Federal Register (36 CFR 219.17(a)(1)). The final ROD documents the rationale for approving the land management plan and is consistent with the Reviewing Officers instructions on objections.
