TEMPORARY AREA AND ROAD CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on the roads and within the areas described in this Order (the “Restricted Area”), and depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Douglas Ranger District, Coronado National Forest, Cochise County, Arizona.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. **36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

RESTRICTED AREA:

As depicted in Exhibit A, the Restricted Area is within Township 19S, Range 30E, SE ¼ of Section 18 also known as Cypress Park Campground.


PURPOSE:

This Order closes Cypress Park Campground to public entry due to flood damage to facilities caused by monsoon storms of August 10, 2019 and the potential for entrapment as a result of subsequent flooding.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be effective on October 28th at midnight, and shall remain in effect until October 31st, 2021, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Exhibit D, "Definitions," is attached and incorporated into this Order.
4. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).



