



Free Christmas Trees for *Every Kid Outdoors*

The Six Rivers National Forest is excited to once again offer free Christmas tree permits to 4th graders who participate in the *Every Kid Outdoors* program, which introduces them to the public lands in their own backyards and beyond.

To receive a free Christmas tree permit, 4th graders or their teachers need to sign up for the program at <https://everykidoutdoors.gov>, then download and print their 4th Grade Pass. They must bring their pass—and a parent or guardian—to any Six Rivers National Forest office to receive their free Christmas tree permit.

The Details: How you, as a 4th grader, can receive a free Christmas tree

1. Obtain a 4th Grade Pass at <https://everykidoutdoors.gov>.
2. Visit any Six Rivers National Forest office with a parent or guardian. You cannot receive a free permit without them!
3. Present your pass to receive a permit and tag for one free Christmas tree.
4. Your parent or guardian will sign the tag. Your name will also be written on the tag.
5. By signing the tag, your parent or guardian agrees to the rules and regulations printed on the permit.
6. We'll write an "F" (for free use) on the tag and circle it (for easy identification by a law enforcement officer).
7. There is a limit of two Christmas tree tags per household. This includes your free tree.
8. Free permits cannot be obtained by mail. You must visit a Six Rivers National Forest office with your parent or guardian.
9. Free permits are only available at Six Rivers National Forest offices. No vendors, such as the Del Norte County Chamber of Commerce, can issue a free permit.



This is an opportunity for you, as a 4th grader, to go out and explore your public lands. We encourage you to help your parents pick out the perfect Christmas tree and enjoy what nature has to offer.
