TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE**

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the roads described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order at Exhibit A, within the North Kaibab Ranger District of the Kaibab National Forest in Coconino County, Arizona.

1. Using a motor vehicle. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.

ROADS DESCRIBED:

National Forest System Road (FR) 632, known as the "Buffalo Ranch Road" from its intersection with FR 3510, for approximately 1/3-mile northwest to its intersection with FR 632B, FR 632B from its intersection with FR 632 north for 2.8 miles to the northwest corner of the current bison holding pasture, and FR 3510A for 2.9 miles north from its intersection with the gate at the southeastern edge of the bison holding pasture northeast to its terminal point at a dead end, inside of the holding pasture, as depicted in Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Order is to restrict motorized access to the roads, which forest and wildlife personnel are utilizing for bison management activities and for the installation of infrastructure improvements along roads within the management planning area. This temporary closure will provide short-term protection of wildlife resources and is also for public health and safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect beginning at 8:00 AM on November 13, 2019, and shall remain in effect until November 13, 2020, or until rescinded, whichever comes first.
2. A map identifying the road closures is attached and is made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581 (b)(7)).
4. 5. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.


