



**Forest Order No. 17-19-02**  
**USDA Forest Service**  
**Tahoe National Forest**  
**Truckee Ranger District**  
**Area, Road and Trail Closure**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Truckee Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This Order is effective from November 14, 2019 through December 15, 2019.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Big Jack East Project Closure Area. The Big Jack East Project Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 06 and Forest Trail No. 16E14, then continues due east to its intersection with the Forest boundary, then continues .35 miles south along the forest boundary, then continues due west to its intersection with Forest Road No. 06-006, then continues west along Forest Road No. 06-006 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 06, then continues north along Forest Road No. 06, back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Big Jack East Project Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Big Jack East Project Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. National Forest Foundation employees, contractors, and subcontractors engaged in operations within Big Jack East Project Closure Area, to the extent authorized by the Forest Service.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
