On July 8, 2019, I signed a letter approving the use of Title II funds for maintenance of county roads in Berkeley County. On October 18, 2019, Berkeley County submitted a letter asking if their portion of the FY2017 and FY2018 Title II funds of \$119,492.87 could be used toward funding the on-going work on the Swamp Fox passage. Berkeley County's request is attached.

Based on my review, this project meets the criteria established in the Secure Rural School Act. Specifically, at the December 10, 2015 committee meeting, the proposal for improvements to the Swamp Fox Passage was reviewed and recommended for funding. On March 16, 2016, I approved funding this project. This letter, with the December 2015 meeting notes are attached.

As the Designated Federal Official, I am approving the use of \$119,492.98 in Title II funds toward the improvements of the Swamp Fox Passage on the Francis Marion National Forest.
