Tawnya Brummett is currently serving as the Acting Forest Supervisor for the Payette National Forest. Tawnya has served as the Deputy Forest Supervisor on the Boise National Forest for the last three years. Tawnya's experience prior to the Boise National Forest includes serving as the Deputy Forest Supervisor on the Tongass NF in SE Alaska; District Ranger on the Lolo National Forest in Montana; Wildlife Biologist and Range Specialist on the Gila National Forest in NM; Wildlife Biologist on the Angelina-Sabine National Forest in East Texas; hotshot fire crewmember on the Gila National Forest as well as various other wildland firefighter appointments. She is also involved in International ICS training and DASP (Disaster Assistance Support Program) through the Office of US Foreign Disaster Assistance (OFDA).
