**Wet Beaver Creek - Fire and Camping Prohibition**

**PROHIBITION:**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the area described in this Order (the “Restricted Area”) and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Red Rock Ranger District, Coconino National Forest, in Yavapai County, Arizona.

1. Building, maintaining, attending and or using a fire, campfire or stove fire.  
**36 C.F.R. § 261.52(a)**
2. Camping. **36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e).**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons using a stove or grill that is solely fueled by liquid petroleum for liquid petroleum gas (LPG) fuels.
2. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
3. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**RESTRICTED AREA:**

The Restricted Area is within Township 15 North, Range 6 East, Sections 21-25, and Township 15 North, Range 7 East, Section 19, specifically, all lands within one-quarter (.25) mile of each side of Bell Trail, starting at the Bell Trail trailhead (located on Forest Road 656, off of Forest Road 618), and continuing approximately one-half mile east, ending just past Wet Beaver Creek Crossing and the section line between Range 6 East,

Section 24, and Range 7 East, Section 19.

**PURPOSE:**

This Order is necessary to protect public's health and safety by maintaining viable ingress and egress for emergency service responses, better protecting nearby communities from the threat of catastrophic wildfires, and decreasing impacts on unique riparian plant, wildlife, and cultural resources associated with Wet Beaver Creek.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be effective on January 29, 2020, at 8 am and shall remain in effect until January 29, 2022, at 8 am, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and is made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.




# Wet Beaver Creek - Campfire and Camping Prohibition




