

ORDER NO. 06-14-06-2020-06
ROAD CLOSURE
UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551, 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following prohibition is established within the Walla Walla Ranger District of the Umatilla National Forest. This order becomes effective at on February 14th, 2020 and will remain in force until July 30, 2020 or the order is rescinded, whichever is sooner.

PROHIBITION:

1. Being on any National Forest System road that have been closed due to storm damage. *36 CFR § 261.54(e)*

STORM DAMAGE ROAD CLOSURE:

The Storm Damage Emergency Road Closures include Forest Service Road (FSR) 3200.

See Exhibit A for road closure map.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons under a special use authorization that allows the otherwise prohibited activity, and approved contractors and their agents directly engaged in approved work outlined in an operating plan or permit.

These restrictions are enacted for public health and safety.

These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart 'A' of 36 CFR 261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.
