On 03/11/2020, at 10:00 AM, sealed bids will be opened in the Shasta-Trinity National Forest Supervisor's Office for the Schell HT FS ReOffer sale. This sale is located in T35N, R6W, Sec 16, 17, 20-22, 28; MDM; Shasta County. Timber sale Contract 2400-6 will be used. The termination date for this sale is 12/31/2020.

Measurement of the estimated quantities will be made after felling. The total estimated quantity on this sale is 1,936 MBF. The Forest Service encourages potential bidders to make their own inspection and estimate prior to bid submission. The Forest Service makes no representation, warranty, or guarantee of the accuracy of the following quantity estimates:

There is a \$100.00 bid guarantee required on this sale.

This sale is located within Tier 2 High Hazard Zone.

Due to the urgent need to harvest this sale contract time may be granted on other sales under specific conditions.

This is a roadside hazard tree removal as a result of the Carr/Delta Fires in 2018.

Product is designated using the Designation by Prescription (C2.355#) provision based upon the Region Five Hazard Tree Guidelines. Acceptance of Work (C6.36#) is included as a companion provision to C2.355#.

There are units within the sale area that are Timber Subject to Agreement, C2.11#, and will only be harvested upon written agreement.

Share Cost Road Liability Insurance is required due to costshare roads within the sale.

In addition to road maintenance deposits there are surface replacement deposits in the amount of \$5.88 per mbf.

This contract contains Special Provision C6.241 Site Specific Special Wildlife Survey Measures. This provision upon written approval allows the purchaser to conduct wildlife surveys when specific requirements are met.

Prospective bidders are encouraged to review the sale area and sample contract documents prior to submission of bids.
