

Order No. 03-20-03
Eldorado National Forest
Northshore Area Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Pacific Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2022.

Being within 200 feet of Ice House Road from a point 1.3 miles east of the intersection of Ice House Road and the Loon Lake Chalet entrance then east to Loon Lake dam, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.
