


2020 Personal Use Firewood Tusayan District - South Zone

The following is applicable to both Paid and Free Permits:

NEW RESOURCE PROTECTION IN EFFECT:
Limit on size of collectable downed wood is 18 inches diameter or less for all species to protect wildlife habitat.

- DO NOT CUT**
- Juniper:** Dead and standing greater than 18 inches in diameter, measured at the 6-inch stump.
 - Ponderosa Pine:** Dead and standing greater than 12 inches diameter, measured 4.5 feet above the ground.
 - Pinyon Pine:** Dead and standing greater than 12 inches in diameter, measured 4.5 feet above the ground.
 - Aspen:** Dead standing greater than 12 inches in diameter, measured 4.5 feet above the ground.
 - Only cut and remove between June 1 and September 30.
 - Oak:** Dead and standing greater than 10 inches in diameter, measured 4.5 feet above the ground.
 - Only cut and remove between June 1 and October 15.

- Do not cut trees that have cavities for wildlife or are within 500 feet of standing water.
- Stump Height must be 6 inches or less.
- Lop and scatter slash to within 18 inches of the ground.
- Do not scatter existing wood piles to collect firewood.



The following is UNIQUE to Paid Personal Use Permits:
A Paid Personal Use Permit holder is prohibited from obtaining a Commercial Fuelwood permit within the given season.
