

Order No. 03-20-05
Eldorado National Forest
Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within National Forest System lands on the Georgetown Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from April 30, 2020, through April 27, 2022.

1. Camping within the Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area, except within a Developed Recreation Site listed in Exhibit A. The Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area is described in Exhibit B and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire within the Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area, except within a Developed Recreation Site listed in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.



The Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area contains two sections. The first section of the Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area encompasses all National Forest System lands located in Section 11, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (MDBM) within 1 mile of Stumpy Meadows Lake.

The second section of the Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area begins at the intersection of the east section boundary and Wentworth Springs Road in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, Mount Diablo Base Meridian (MDBM), then continues due south for approximately 0.07 miles to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, MDBM, then west along the property boundary for approximately 0.75 miles following the National Forest boundary of the northern half of the southeast quarter of Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, MDBM, then continues northeast for approximately 0.3 miles following the high water line of Stumpy Meadows Reservoir to the west section boundary of Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, MDBM, then continues due north for approximately 0.4 miles to the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 12 North, Range 12 East, MDBM, then continues east for approximately 0.16 miles following the property boundary of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 12 East, MDBM to the ridge line, then continues southeast for approximately 0.25 miles following the ridge line to the Wentworth Springs Road, then continues southeast approximately 0.6 miles along the Wentworth Springs Road back to the starting point.
