OCCUPANCY AND USE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land within the Dixie National Forest.

1. Camping in the same developed campground or other developed recreation site for a period in excess of 14 consecutive days or for more than 14 days in any 30-day period. [36 CFR § 261.58(a)].
2. Camping within 10 miles of the same location for more than 16 consecutive days, or for more than 16 days in a 60 day time period. [36 CFR § 261.58(a)].
3. Camping in a developed campground or developed recreation site that is closed [36 CFR § 261.58(a)].
4. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. [36 CFR § 261.58(g)].

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

DEFINITIONS:

Camping is defined as the temporary use of National Forest system land for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure. 36 CFR 261.2.

Camping Equipment is defined as personal property used in or suitable for camping, and includes any vehicle used for transportation and all equipment in possession of a person camping. 36 CFR 261.2.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until May 15, 2025, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b) (7)].

4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order.
