

**ORDER**  
**EMERGENCY CLOSURE**  
**WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(a), and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within; in the White River National Forest in Eagle County within the state of Colorado. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.54 (e) Being on the road with a bicycle or motorized vehicles.


Forest Service Roads 747 Wearyman and 708 McAllister are closed to bicycle and motorized travel for public safety due to high water conditions and resulting landslides.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, Local or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order becomes effective May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and will remain in force until December 31, 2021 or until rescinded.
