UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
HEBER-KAMAS RANGER DISTRICT

TEMPORARY ROADS CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following act is prohibited** on the National Forest System roads as described in the order. The roads affected are all within the Heber-Kamas Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect May 21, 2020 through June 30, 2020 or until further notice.

1. **Being in or upon Squaw Creek (Forest Service road #110) and Horse Creek (Forest Service road #652)** as described below and as shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian, equestrian, bicycle and any type of motorized vehicle.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The roads closed are Forest Service road #652 from the junction with Forest Service road #131 to junction with Forest Service road #715 and Forest Service road #110 from Forest Service road #131 to Forest Service #518, located in Township 4 South, Range 12 West, Sections 10 and 11, all within the Uintah Based Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the Order is for public health and safety while crews and heavy equipment are working on a vegetation management project.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed May 21, 2020 and shall remain in effect until June 30, 2020 or until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
