AREA CLOSURE

Mountain View Campground Reconstruction
For Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on National Forest System Lands, within the administrative boundaries of the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect beginning at **5:00 P.M. on May 21, 2020** and shall remain in effect through **December 1, 2020**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Going into or being upon the Area described below. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION

Mountain View Campground Area is closed to all public entry and is described as the entire campground, including all interior Roads up to the high water mark of the South Fork Payette River, located along Highway 21 north of Lowman, ID at Township 9 North, Range 7 East, Section 35, Boise Meridian.

The described Area is shown on the Map attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is within the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho.

PURPOSE

The Mountain View Campground Area described above, is closed to public entry in order to provide for public safety due to reconstruction of the campground.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect beginning at **5:00 P.M. on May 21, 2020** and shall remain in effect through **December 1, 2020**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.
2. A map identifying the above-described Area is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this Order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous Orders/notices for the above-described Roads or portions thereof.
