



SCENIC VIEWPOINTS

BUCK FARM VIEWPOINT

Attractions: This scenic drive takes you off the east rim into House Rock Valley. As the Kaibab Plateau spreads out to the west, rolling pinyon and juniper woodlands cross the buffalo range. The overlook offers a spectacular view of Marble Canyon and the Colorado River, with the Vermilion Cliffs to the north and Navajo Mountain to the east.

Fee: None.

Access: From Kaibab Plateau Visitor Center go east on US 89A for about 20 miles to Forest Development Road (FDR) 8910. Turn right and go about 23.5 miles to the fork in FDR 8910. Take the left fork and go another 2 miles to FDR 445H. Follow FDR 445H for about 3 miles to the end of the road. A short hike of 100 yards or so will allow you to look directly into Marble Canyon. FDR 8910 is suitable for passenger cars. While on FDR 445H, a high clearance vehicle is recommended.

Water & Facilities: None. Bring everything that you will need.

Round Trip Driving Distance from Kaibab Plateau Visitor Center: 97 miles.

Elevation: 5500 feet.

Recommended Season of Use: From late spring to early fall, depending on weather. Be prepared for summer thunderstorms.

CRAZY JUG VIEWPOINT

Attractions: A beautiful drive leads through a Ponderosa pine forest to this view of the Grand Canyon looking into Tapeats Amphitheater. The spectacular canyonlands panorama includes: Fishtail Mesa to the west, Steamboat Mountain, and Powell Plateau to the south.

Fee: None.

Access: Turn right on Forest Development Road (FDR) 461 1/4 mile south of Kaibab Plateau Visitor Center on AZ 67. Go 5.5 miles on FDR 461 to FDR 462; go right on FDR 462 for 3 miles to the intersection of FDR 22. Turn left for about 12 miles to FDR 425; turn right onto FDR 425 and follow this road for 10 miles to FDR 292; turn right onto FDR 292 for 1.5 miles, then turn left onto FDR 292B to the end of the road at Crazy Jug Viewpoint. All roads are suitable for passenger cars.

Water and Facilities: None. Bring everything that you will need.

Round Trip Driving Distance from Kaibab Plateau Visitor Center: 64 miles.

Elevation: 7450 feet.

Recommended Season of Use: From late spring to early fall, depending on weather. Be prepared for summer thunderstorms.
