Brian Head Post Fire Trail, Road, and Yankee Meadow Campground Closure

This Order rescinds and replaces Order Number 04071814 issued on August 24, 2018.

A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50, it is prohibited to be upon the roads, trails, and developed facilities as described in this Order, located within the Cedar City Ranger District, Dixie National Forest, which are closed for public safety due to post wildland fire hazards and wildland fire recovery.

1. **It is prohibited to be upon the roads, trails, and, developed sites as described below, which are closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety.36 CFR 261.54(e); 261.55(a).**
2. **Camping in a developed campground or developed recreation site that is closed [36 CFR § 261.58(a)].**

B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order.

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

C. AREA DESCRIBED

The following trails, roads, developed sites and overnight camping are closed until May 13, 2021, or until this Order is rescinded:

Forest Road: 2380 Yankee Meadows Campground road.

Forest Trails: Dark Hollow Trail (32032), and Left Fork of Bunker Creek Trail (32033).

Forest developed sites: Yankee Meadows Campground.

See map attached hereto as Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference.

D. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety from post fire hazards from the Brain Head Fire.

E. IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Special Order implementing Area Closure Restrictions is effective on Tuesday, May 20, 2020 at 12 noon and shall remain in effect until May 13, 2021 or until rescinded, whichever is sooner.


2. Exhibit A, Map.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization and/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months [Title 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
