THIS ORDER TERMINATES FOREST ORDER NO. 08-05-04-20-078

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Title 16 U.S.C. § 551 and the authority vested in me pursuant to Title 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), I am hereby terminating Forest Order No. 08-05-04-20-078, in its entirety, effective immediately.

A. Termination of Order No. 08-05-04-20-078: Effective immediately, the following prohibition established by Forest Order No. 08-05-04-20-078, is no longer in effect:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(a).

B. Remaining Applicability of Other Prohibitions: The following prohibitions remain in effect:

- (a) the General Prohibitions at 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.1–261.23 (Subpart A);
- (b) other Orders currently in effect pursuant to 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.50–261.58 (Subpart B); and
- (c) all other Regional Regulations at 36 C.F.R. § 261.70 (Subpart C).
