SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT

TEMPORARY TRAIL AND AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System trail and area described in this order. The trail and area affected is located on the Salt Lake Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting May 25, 2020 through July 4, 2020 or until rescinded.

1. **Being in or upon** the Lower Albion Meadow trail (Forest Service trail #1006) as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian and motorized vehicles. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]
2. **Being in or upon the area** which includes the Albion Basin parking lot and the cat shop as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian and motorized vehicles. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Lower Albion Meadow trail (Forest Service trail #1006) is closed for a distance of 1.5 miles located in Township 3 South, Range 3 East, Sections 4 and 5 all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian. As shown on the attached map.

The area closure includes the Albion Basin parking lot and the cat shop located in Township 3 South, Range 3 South, Section 5 all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian, as shown on attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety while ski resort crews and equipment are implementing a ski slope grading project.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed May 25, 2020 and shall remain in effect until July 4, 2020 or until rescinded.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
